Seize this Opportunity

- Take stock of the supports you are providing
- Celebrate success
- Analyze data to identify areas for improvement

Considerations

- Types of schooling
- Tiers of instruction/support
- Access
- Effectiveness

Types of Schooling

- Think about the options your district is currently providing (or has provided at some point this school year) and categorize those options in a way that makes sense to you
- Examples:
 - Virtual schooling provided by a district-selected vendor,
 - In-person full-time schooling
 - Remote synchronous schooling
 - Remote asynchronous schooling
 - Hybrid of in-person and remote schooling

Tiers of Instruction/Support

- What supports were offered to **ALL** students/families?
- What supports were offered to **SOME** students/families?
- What supports were provided to just **A FEW** students/families with specific needs?

Measuring Access

- Within each option, consider the supports provided to ALL, SOME and just A FEW students
 - How many students accessed each option?
 - How many students have not accessed any of these options?
 - What patterns are you seeing in who accessed which supports?

Possible Data Sources

- Example data sources across schooling types:
 - Percent of students routinely attending in-person and/or synchronous remote instruction
 - Frequency of logins and daily minutes of participation in online learning platforms
 - Surveys
 - Percent of instructional packets picked up
 - Percent of check-in calls that were answered

Measuring Effectiveness

- Social/emotional impact
 - Think about how you can measure behavioral indicators of engagement, connectedness and positivity across the schooling types
- Academic impact
 - Think about how you can measure academic impact from data you already have available: grades, benchmark assessments, performance data from online learning platforms
