

Create Your Own Survey

This document provides considerations and an example if a School Leadership Team (SLT) is going to create their own survey for staff, students, and families.

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Some schools choose to create their own survey. If choosing to do so, here are some considerations:

- The survey should be the same for staff, families, and students to allow for comparisons across the groups
- Consider collecting surveys electronically (i.e. Survey Monkey)
- Be strategic about when and how you collect the surveys (i.e., staff meetings, during computer lab, etc.)
- Consider how the survey should be adapted for the grade levels in your building

The following survey could be disseminated to staff, students, and families. It is fairly straight forward and provides the SLT with information related to school climate.
