Grade-Level Team Structures Checklist

Grade-Level Teams provide an important structure within an MTSS framework designed to support the high-quality use of reading curriculum resources, common instructional practices to support the range of learners, and use of assessments for continuous improvements at their grade level. This document outlines the common structures to support successful grade-level team meetings. Coaches will review each item in the table below, determine the current status within their building, and identify which recommendations the School Leadership Team will consider during the upcoming training session.
