EC PBIS Leadership Team Installation Checklist

This document provides the items an EC PBIS Leadership Team should complete during the installation stage as they work toward full implementation.

Share an overview of EC PBIS with all staff.
Ensure buy-in through a staff poll in which 80% of staff indicate they are aware of and support implementation.
Develop 2-5 program-wide expectations with family and staff input.
Develop concrete rules for common areas connected to the expectations with family and staff input.
Create posters or other visual displays of expectations and rules throughout the common areas.
Develop a plan to share the program-wide expectations and Pyramid Model information with families in multiple ways throughout the year.
All teaching teams have been trained in Pyramid Practices.
All classrooms have developed concrete rules for classroom settings and activities connected to the expectations with family input.
All classrooms have visuals posted of the expectations and rules.
The Teaching Pyramid Observation Tool (TPOT) was completed in all preschool classrooms.
Practice-based Coaching is being used in all classrooms to support the implementation of the Pyramid Model practices.
Complete the baseline administration of the Early Childhood Benchmarks of Quality (BOQ) with the support of your Leadership Team Coach.
Complete a follow-up administration of the Early Childhood BOQ approximately 6 months after the baseline assessment.
Behavior Incident Report (BIR) data is collected in all classrooms and analyzed monthly at the program level by the EC PBIS Leadership Team.

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
