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Example Behavior Matrix for Intervention Groups

Expectations	Intervention Group	When You Feel Upset
Safe	Keep your hands, feet, and objects to yourself	Communicate your needs to the adult
Responsible	- Do not be late to class - Get your materials for REWARDS Secondary out - Begin the warm-up activity - Clean up area and return materials to the bin	Ask for a break if you feel upset
Respectful	- Answer when prompted - Use kind words and support your classmates - Believe in yourself!	Accept help when it is offered
Interventionist's Role	- Prepared lessons ahead of time - Acknowledge students as they arrive - Prompt check-in on feelings at the start of each intervention session	- Acknowledge when feeling upset - Model think aloud for why you are upset - Accept help

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
