Getting Ready for a Secondary School-wide Literacy Framework

This document provides possible readiness activities, as well as a recommended training sequence, for the development and use of a secondary school-wide literacy framework.

Readiness Activities

Implementing a school-wide literacy framework requires thinking about systems, practices, and data. The following are possible activities to build readiness within your school or district.

Systems

- Identify individuals who could sit on a secondary literacy leadership team at your school. This must include the school principal. Use the <u>School Leadership Team Recruitment</u> <u>and Selection</u> document, and review the <u>School Leadership Team Formation Module</u> video.
- Consider who could serve as a secondary literacy leadership team coach.
- Identify individuals who would have the time and expertise to provide classroom coaching to teaching teams. This could be a literacy coach or teacher leader.
- Begin thinking about how to develop family partnerships (e.g., identify family organizations that could provide input and support the work).
- Begin thinking about staff readiness: is there a need to develop a plan to foster staff buyin?

Practices

• Complete an <u>Initiative Inventory</u> to take stock of current curriculum materials, programs, or strategies used in your classrooms that address literacy instruction and intervention.

Data

- Determine what implementation (fidelity) and impact (outcome) data is already being collected within your program and where gaps might exist.
- Identify an individual or individuals to administer the <u>Reading Tiered Fidelity Inventory</u> (<u>R-TFI</u>) Version 2.1 Secondary-Level Edition. These individuals must complete the R-TFI courses in <u>EduPaths</u> to become R-TFI Facilitators.



Recommended Training Sequence

Although there are a number of paths, the following is the recommended training sequence for schools interested in implementing a secondary school-wide literacy framework with fidelity. Registration is available through <u>Professional Learning</u> section of the MiMTSS TA Center website.

1. Tier 1 Reading Components of a Secondary MTSS Framework

- Audience: Leadership Team members and Leadership Team Coach
- Includes a separate Coaching Support Session for literacy leadership team coaches

2. Secondary Content Area Literacy Strategy: Text Summarization using Writing Frames (currently available under the alternate training title: Secondary Content Literacy Strategies: Because Learning is NOT a Spectator Sport)

- Audience: All Leadership Team members, coaches, and teaching staff
- Staff will be trained in a literacy strategy designed to enhance written expression skills while supporting their comprehension of text across content-area subjects. This strategy will support the installation and implementation of a MTSS literacy framework at the secondary level.

Additional School-Wide Content Area Literacy Strategies Trainings Intended to Support Tier 1 Literacy Instruction Within an MTSS Framework

Active Participation and Alternative Reading Strategies (currently available under the alternate training title: Secondary Content Literacy Strategies: Because Learning is NOT a Spectator Sport)

- Audience: All leadership team members, coaches, and teaching staff
- Staff will be trained in a literacy strategy designed for school-wide implementation to support the installation and implementation of a MTSS literacy framework at the secondary level.

Explicit Vocabulary Instruction (currently available under the alternate training title: Secondary Content Literacy Strategies: Because Learning is NOT a Spectator Sport)

- Audience: All leadership team members, coaches, and teaching staff
- Staff will be trained in a generalizable, four-step instructional delivery model to activate students' comprehension of complex texts. This strategy is designed to support the school-wide installation and implementation of a MTSS literacy framework at the secondary level.
